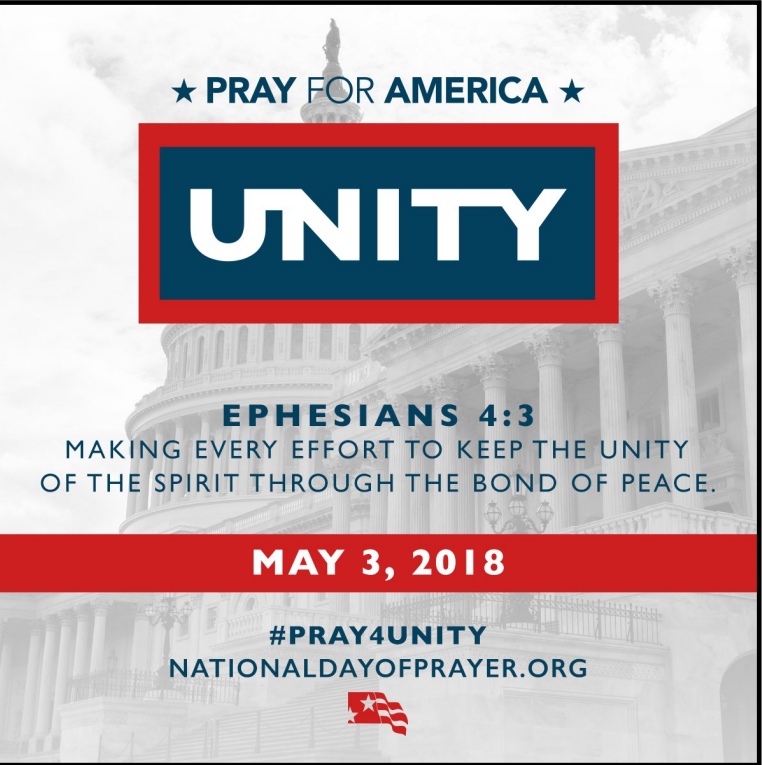

We need at least 4 adults who are available to teach Sunday School for the months of June and July! Let me know if you can make this short term commitment.

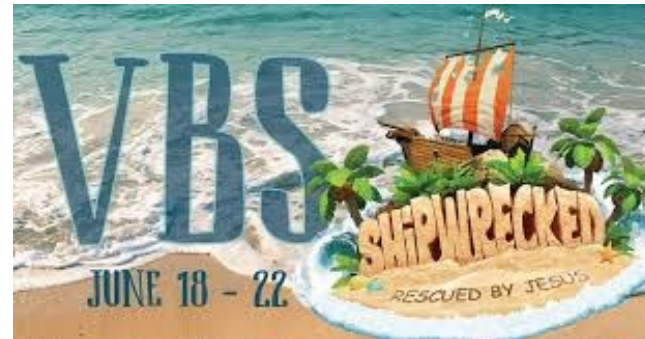

36 kids and adults from MUMC Student Ministry participated in SIFAT Slum Experience in Lineville, Alabama from April 20—22.



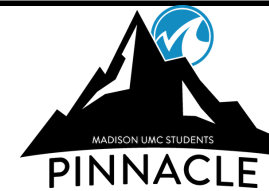
