

MADISON UMC CHURCH CONFERENCE RESULTS AND UPDATES

Our special called Church Conference was held on Sunday, March 26. There were 664 ballots cast at the church conference. 57 votes (8.6%) were cast to remain with the United Methodist denomination and 605 votes (91.4%) were cast to disaffiliate from the United Methodist denomination. There were two abstentions. Special thanks go to our tellers, greeters, nursery workers, and church staff for their extra help with this meeting.

Our request for disaffiliation will be voted on at the Mississippi Annual Conference meeting on June 28. We will remain a United Methodist congregation until the first week of July. We will learn what our final disaffiliation costs will be very soon and we will share that with you when we receive that information. The Book of Discipline requires that we pay two years of apportionments and any unfunded pension liabilities to disaffiliate. Our Finance Committee has set aside significant funds for this, and they have a plan in place for this expense.

The Administrative Council will meet soon to finalize plans for our church's discernment process regarding moving to another denomination. As we did with the disaffiliation process, there will be ample opportunities for conversation and for sharing information before our church members vote.

MUMC will participate in building a new house with Habitat for Humanity during May and June. This project is named the "Faith Build" because it will be funded and built as a cooperative effort by the congregations of Methodist, Episcopal, Catholic, Presbyterian, Baptist, and non-denominational churches in the Mississippi Capitol area. The home is being built for Latonia Blackmon and her five children and will have five bedrooms and two and a half bathrooms. It will be located at 4663 Estelle Drive in the Broadmoor neighborhood in Jackson.

Workdays will be Thursday and Saturday of each week beginning April 29 and continuing to completion in late June. MUMC will have a dedicated day on <u>June 3</u>, when we will be completing the walls by installing sheathing, top plates, and plumbing the walls in preparation to installing roof trusses.
