General Conference

THE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH

General Conference will be held on February 23-26. Please be praying for the delegates and for this process. Whatever happens at this General Conference, it will lead to a change on many levels in our denomination.

I want to remind everyone that, whatever you may hear reported in the media, only the General Conference as a whole can speak for the United Methodist Church. I encourage you to be patient with the process, keep your trust in the Lord, and pray continually for God's will to be done.

We will provide a briefing on the results immediately after the conference on Wednesday, February 27 at 6:15 p.m. in the Sanctuary. Bishop Swanson will also provide a post-conference report and share his thoughts on Sunday, March 24 at 3:00 p.m. at Christ United Methodist Church in Jackson. Our church family is invited to that meeting. Our Administrative Council has been discussing the upcoming Conference for some time now, and will be meeting on April 2 to begin considering any action that might need to be taken by Madison UMC in response to the decisions made by the General Conference. Any response our leaders recommend would be a process that would ultimately involve the participation of the whole church. Our hope is that we will not need to respond at all, but we will be preparing to do so as needed.

GENERAL CONFERENCE 2019 PRAYER GUIDE

In 2016 the United Methodist Church established a Commission on a Way Forward to look at issues concerning human sexuality, particularly as related to clergy, and bring forth proposals to be considered at a called General Conference, which will be held February 23-26, 2019 in St. Louis, MO. God is at work in our Wesleyan movement and we ask for your prayers this week during this important gathering of the United Methodist Church.

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 22 - GATHERING TOGETHER

Pray for safe and easy travels for the delegates and those leading and attending, especially for those making the difficult journey from overseas. *"The LORD will keep you from all harm - he will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore (Psalm 121:7-8)."*

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 23 - DAY OF PRAYER AND WORSHIP

Pray for the Holy Spirit to bring peace and purpose to this day set apart for prayer and worship. *"[Jesus said] the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid (John 14:26-27)."*

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 24 - OPENING AND ORGANIZATION

Pray for the organizing efforts to be accomplished smoothly and in a spirit of cooperation. *"For God is not a God of disorder but of peace - as in all the congregations of the Lord's people (1 Corinthians 14:33)."*

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 25 - LEGISLATIVE REVIEW AND DISCUSSION

Pray that the presentations and discussion will be marked by Christian love for one another and informed by God's wisdom. *"Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ (Ephesians 4:15)."*

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 26 - CLOSING DEBATES AND DECISIONS

Pray that the debates and decisions of the General Conference delegates will be guided by truth and in accordance with God's will for his Church. *"Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight (Proverbs 3:5-6)."*

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 27 - RETURN AND REPORT

Pray again for safe and simple travels and for grace filled reporting regarding the work of General Conference 2019. *"Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen (Hebrews 13:20-21)"*

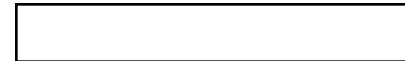

CHECK-in SUNDAY MORNING CHECK-IN GUIDELINES

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. Our volunteers & staff members complete a background check & training to ensure your child's safety.

ALL children, infants - 5th grade, have to be checked in by a parent or guardian.

- Infants, Crawlers, Toddlers, Younger 2's & Older 2's check in at the Nursery Check-In located off the East Hall outside our Sanctuary.
- Three year olds – 5th graders check in at our *kids* Check-In Desk located in the Atrium of the Education Building. This will be the only entry point to the Children's Hall. There will be NO entrance from the upstairs hall or through the exterior north door.

Upon arrival, someone at our Check-In Desks will help you register your children. When you check in using our computerized check in system, you will be given a randomly generated security code (it changes weekly) assigned only to your family. The code will print on a name tag for each child & one will print for you, the parent or guardian. This tag will also include any medical notes, such as allergies, that your child may have. The tag must be presented when picking up your child. The teacher will keep the parent/guardian tag.

Please note:

- We do not allow elementary age children to check in or pick up their siblings.
- Children are NOT allowed to use or play with the iPads.

CHURCH-WIDE BIBLE READING PLAN/BIBLE PROJECT

Featured Videos to Help You Understand the Bible Reading & Discipleship



If you are accessing our MUMC Church-Wide Bible Reading Plan electronically (either by visiting/following the blog directly at www.readpraylovedaily.com, or accessing it through the MUMC mobile app's "Bible" tab), you will see a brand new post every day. The daily Bible reading is listed below the section "We Listen to God's Word." The Bible passage can be read directly from the blog post, or you can follow the red hyperlink to read the daily Bible chapter from Bible Gateway (where you can switch translations if you desire).

Beneath the daily Bible reading link/passage is a **featured video**. We will primarily feature videos from "**The Bible Project**" (<https://thebibleproject.com/>) or "**Seedbed**" (<https://www.seedbed.com/videos/>). These videos will primarily have to do with understanding a book of the Bible or theme we are covering. Periodically, they will be videos focusing on an aspect of Biblical discipleship not necessarily highlighted in that week's Bible reading. **You could listen to the audio of these short videos on your commute or while you are working out, etc.** To see a growing master "playlist" of videos we anticipate featuring over time, please go to www.youtube.com, and search for "Read. Pray. Love. Daily. – Bible".

These featured videos will not necessarily change from one day to the next. For instance, on the week of January 20-26, we featured the following videos: Sunday (the Luke 1-9 Bible Project video), Monday (the Luke 1-2 "Mini-Series" Bible Project video), Tuesday-Thursday (the Genesis 1-11 Bible Project video, posted three successive days), and Friday-Saturday (the "Image of God" theme Bible Project video, posted two successive days). On Thursday, January 31, 2019, we featured our former MUMC member Dr. Sandy Richter's Seedbed video on "Genesis 1." Remember, you can always click back to older posts at the bottom of the blog home screen ("Older Posts"), or you can click on the "Menu" tab near the top of the blog and then click on "Restart 3-Year Bible Plan" tab to find past Bible reading links and that week's featured videos.
