

VBS UPDATE - A BIG THANK YOU!

Thanks to ALL of you who helped make VBS 2023 an incredible experience for our kids! We had fun learning how to shine Jesus' love all the time! Every part - the decorations, snacks, center leaders, shepherds, student leaders, sound booth, mission donations, custodial support, donations from Naomi Ruth Circle & prayers – made a difference this week. Our mission project raised over \$1500 to help provide snacks, craft supplies, toys, & books for the KIDS programs that the Moody's (our missionaries in Honduras) are providing for children in their immediate area.



Our 2023-24 Sunday School year begins on August 6! I know you have "reasons" for believing teaching Sunday School is not your gift, not your thing, etc., but ... as I was rereading Christopher Miles Ritter's Seven Things John Wesley Expected Us to Do for Kids, this really hit home – "We are called to ministry with children "gift or no gift." As wonderful and needful as spiritual gifts are to the church, the lack of these gifts is not a legitimate excuse for non-participation. To minister to children, as we ought, we are going to need to stretch ourselves. We need to move past our comfort, over our excuses, outside our perceived gifts, and beyond..."

But, I'm not qualified ... You do NOT have to be a Bible scholar to share Jesus with our children; you ONLY need a heart for Jesus and a desire to share His love!

But I need to attend my Sunday School class to grow in my personal faith ... the blessings you receive from sharing your love for Jesus and the relationships you develop with our children (and their parents) will help fuel your personal faith journey!

But I don't want to teach every Sunday ... we do ask for a school year commitment (a semester at a minimum) because the same teacher(s) every Sunday helps reassure the children, helps the children develop lasting relationships with Christian mentors, and helps improve the learning environment. You can always ask a friend to "team teach" with you; this allows you to work around vacations, ball games, etc.

But ... if you have questions or concerns about teaching, the commitment, etc., please let me know!

TESTIMONIES FROM THE SALT & LIGHT HONDURAS MISSION TEAM

John Smith - "As the saying goes, "Best trip yet", except Phil wasn't there. The MMC team was involved in many areas of ministry during the 7 days. MMC sponsored the construction of a 3-bedroom house for the Sanchez-Diaz family and their 5 children, ages ranging from 15 down to 3. The father and oldest son, Anderson, worked in the construction alongside our team, consisting of me and members of Fannin Baptist Church. We had two teams consisting of two people each involved in door-to-door evangelism. I had the honor of being a part of one team every afternoon. We met some wonderful Honduran people, carried the Word of God to several people and families and met several that were strong believers of Christ as well as others that did not believe. All of those who had not accepted Jesus were lead in the reading of Scripture, given Bibles with key verses highlighted and asked to read and study. I had many people from other churches come to me complimenting the "girls from Madison" and their spirit, energy and knowledge of God's Word. They became known as the "Bumblebees"... I will let them explain!"

Alexis Ainsworth - "Beginning our days in the village of Las Lavitas, we were welcomed with loads of love and laughter from the kids in the community. After having a fun VBS day, consisting of storytelling, arts and crafts, music, and recreational games, along with our greatly appreciated translators helping everything go accordingly, we would eat some lunch. Most days we would have enough to share with the kids as well! In the afternoons we went where we were needed- whether that be painting a school in another village or carrying cinder blocks down a mountain to help with the construction team and we LOVED it! We had the opportunity to walk through the villages of Honduras and encounter their culture, people, and scenery and there was no doubt God had a hand in every act of service our team had done during our stay! It was wonderful!"
