MUMC DISAFFILIATION COSTS

The Mississippi Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church will vote on our church's disaffiliation on June 28. Our final disaffiliation cost from the annual conference to cover two years of apportionments and any unfunded pension liability is \$976,014. We have paid approximately \$135,000 in apportionments this year so we will pay the annual conference \$841,000 in early July. Here are our additional expenses for the disaffiliation process:

New chapel and sanctuary hymnals (\$13,000) Updated outdoor signage (\$5,000) Stained-glass window redesign and installation (\$10,000) Administrative expenses (\$2,000) Technical Assistance (website, email, etc.) - \$3,000 Publication Assistance - \$4,000 Signage for vans - \$3,000

CHURCH AFFILIATION VOTE TOTALS

Our church's membership voted on Sunday, May 21, to seek affiliation with the Global Methodist Church. With 433 votes cast, 14 people voted for Congregational Methodist, 418 people voted for Global Methodist, and 1 person abstained.
