

For the past several months the Staff Parish Relations Committee has been engaged in interviews for an Associate Pastor. They interviewed qualified candidates from Mississippi as well as other states. We announced on Sunday, November 26, that Rev. Robert McCormick will be appointed to Madison Methodist Church as our Associate Pastor.

Robert is currently the Associate Pastor at Trinity Methodist Church in Gulfport. A native of the Mississippi Gulf Coast, Robert is a graduate of Ole Miss and the Mississippi College School of Law. He and his wife Shaunna served together in ministry for several years before he was called into full-time ministry. Robert is a graduate of Asbury Theological Seminary with a Masters of Divinity and he will be ordained an Elder in the Global Methodist Church in January.
